State climate program could fuel jump in gas prices


A nearly two decades-old program to slash climate-warming emissions from transportation could cause California gasoline prices to spike as much as 50 cents a gallon in the next two years. That's according to staff of the state's leading air quality regulator, who provided the estimate


ahead of that agency's decision to strengthen the program created to discourse
